Discord is an online platform aimed at gamers. The platform is available through web browsers, a mobile app, and it can also be accessed via Xbox. Discord's Terms of Service requires its users to be 13+ to use the platform. It allows users to interact using voice, text and images through closed groups known as 'servers'.

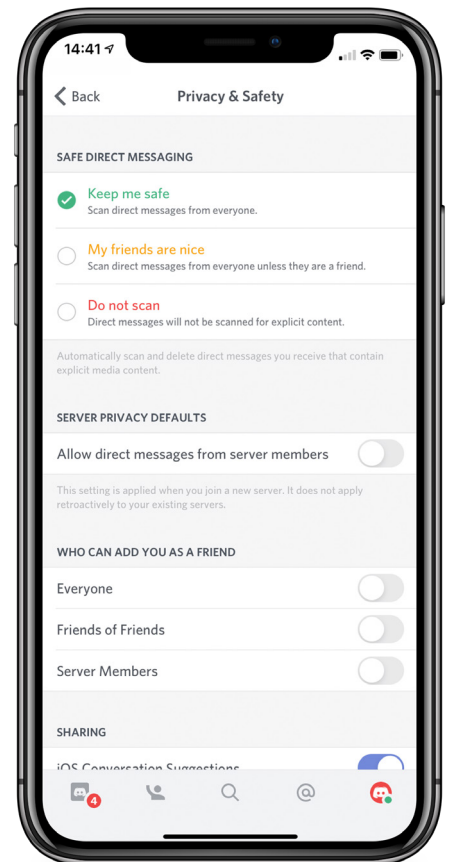
Stay safe on Discord using the instructions on **Blocking**, **Safe Direct Messaging** and **Privacy** below.



## Safe Direct Messaging

Automatically scan and delete messages you receive:

- Tap on your profile picture in the bottom right corner.
- Tap on **Privacy & Safety**.
- Select from the three options '**Keep me safe**', '**My friends are nice**' and '**Do not scan**'.



## Block

Block a user using these simple instructions:

- On the users profile, tap on ●●●
- Tap on **Block**.

## Privacy

Control who can add you as a friend:

- Tap on your profile picture in the bottom right corner.
- Tap on **Privacy & Safety**.
- Scroll down to '**Who can add you as a friend**'.
- Select from the three options '**Everyone**', '**Friends of Friends**' and '**Server Members**'.
