Privacy

Adjust your privacy settings on your Facebook account:

- From here you can configure **Message Delivery** and **Secret Conversations**.

Block

Block a user using these simple instructions:

- At the top of your conversation, tap on the user's profile picture that you want to block.
- Scroll down and tap **Block**.
 - Here you can block on Messenger and on Facebook.

Report

Report a user using these simple instructions:

- At the top of your conversation, tap on the user's profile picture that you want to block.
- Scroll down and tap **Something's Wrong**.
 - Let Messenger know why you want to report them.
- Tap on Send Feedback.
