- Tap on Settings.
- Tap on Security and Privacy.
- Tap the toggle to activate Block Whispers from Strangers.



## **Report a Live Stream**

Report a livestream using these simple instructions:

- Tap on the settings cog on the top right corner of the video.
- Scroll down to the bottom and tap Report [username].
- A pop-up will appear stating: You are reporting [username] for the current live stream.
- Choose why you are submitting this report, tap **Next** and follow the on-screen instructions.



## Report a User:

Report a user using these simple instructions:

- Tap on their username.
- Tap the three dots on the top right corner.
- Tap Report [username].
- A pop-up message will appear stating: You are reporting [username].
- Choose why you are submitting this report, tap **Next** and follow the on-screen instructions.
